

RULES FOR SUPERVISED STUDY

The following rules have been set in place in order to create the most favourable study environment for each student.

- (i) Students will swipe in before each session so that we will have an electronic record of attendance.
- (ii) Students are expected to be punctual and to come prepared with all their material.
- (iii) No student will be allowed to the locker room after the study session has commenced.
- (iv) Students are not permitted to talk to each other at any stage of the session.
- (v) Students are not permitted to pass books or copies to each other.
- (vi) Students may drink water. However, all other drinks are not permitted.
- (vii) Students may not eat during the study period.
- (viii) If a student is absent, a note, signed by a parent/guardian, must be handed to the supervisor the following day.
- (ix) If a student needs to leave early, a note, written by a parent/guardian must be presented in advance.

Please note:

- It is important to the smooth running of study that these rules are observed. Failure to comply with them may lead to a suspension from supervised study.
- In the case of a special occasion where there is a half-day, there will be no study. However, in the case of school finishing early due to staff, parent/teacher or curriculum planning meetings, study will proceed fifteen minutes after school ends. Such dates may be checked on the school calendar.
- Supervised study will not be available during the February exams.
